Club Membership stands at 84, up 8 on last month! The Club web site at www.melbsportsbike.net.au accumulated 662 hits during March, up 217 on last month. Total site visits are 74,282 since April 1996. The counters on the other pages after another month indicate that the 2012 Ride Calendar page took 612 hits (total 21,695 since 28th October 2008) and Great Roads 125 hits (total 5585).

For March, the official kilometres (sum of ride lengths) for the month is 3,628 km (up 2285 km on last month – 7 rides for the month). Official Club kilometres for the month (people x ride length) is 46,386, up 29,674 on last month.

The average calendar yearly total is 336,393 km since 2005. This year we are up to **113,058** km with only minor injuries, all incurred in the last month.

The **Club Participant of the Year** is based on aggregate points accumulated at 1 point per ride, an extra point for leading or being rear rider, and 1 point per magazine article (maximum 2 per magazine). Attending one or more days of a weekend event scores 3 points for leading, 3 for rear riding duties and 2 points for participating.

The same top ten, but some minor reshuffling of the order: Pina slipped back past Ron into second position. It is very close between Ron, Rob and Marc.
