## Who's News November 2012

**Club Membership** stands at a very healthy **92** after five months of renewals, up two this month. Welcome to new members **Glenn Aspden** on a Suzuki GSXR1000 and **Garry Boucher** on a Kawasaki ZX14, both keen and experienced riders. We wish them many safe and fun rides.

The Club web site at www.melbsportsbike.net.au accumulated 661 hits during November, up 70 on last month. Total site visits are 79,067 since April 1996. The counters on the other pages after another month indicate that the 2012 Ride Calendar page took 641 hits (total 26,117 since 28<sup>th</sup> October 2008) and Great Roads 119 hits (total 6360). Status quo is maintained with the Home page taking slightly more hits than the Calendar page.

For <u>November</u> the official kilometres (sum of ride lengths) for the month is **3574 km** (up 2214 km on last month – Melb Cup 4 day epic massively distorted the figures). Official Club kilometres for the month (people x ride length) is **71,555**, up 48,104 km on last month, all of which can be attributed to the huge (33 people) on the Melb Cup Weekend ride to Corryong.

The average calendar yearly total is 336,393 km since 2005. This year we are up to **333,928** km with a total of twenty-three crashes (up five this month, 4 minor, 1 serious). Those five crashes made a mess of our figures with km per crash down to 14,519 km (long term 21,214) and 111,309 km between serious injuries, slightly better than the long term average of 102,381. Cheeky's two crashes on the Simpson ride hit all the buttons: first time rider, one minor crash, one major crash (broken collar bone).

The **Club Participant of the Year** is based on aggregate points accumulated at 1 point per ride, an extra point for leading or being rear rider, and 1 point per magazine article (maximum 2 per magazine). Attending one or more days of a weekend event scores 3 points for leading, 3 for rear riding duties and 2 points for participating.

The 2012/13 count is up and running and after **five** months the top eleven positions are: **Ben Warden** (47), **Rob Langer** (28), **Pina Garasi** (27.5), **Ron Johnston** (26), **Cliff Peters** (24), **Paul Southwell** (23), **Tony Stegmar** (21), **Ian Payne** (20.5), **Simon Wastney** (19) and **Misho Zrakic** (19). Lots of movement this month with Rob jumping past Pina, Ron skipping past Cliff, Tony jumping a couple of places and Ian coming from outside the 10 to displace Dave Byrne and Andrew Newbury. Rob, Ron, Pina and Cliff are within a couple of points of each other.
