Club Membership stands at a very healthy **99** after seven months of renewals, up three this month. Welcome to new member Ronny (Kawasaki ZX6), and renewals from Ray Weston (KTM 990) and Bart Hutchinson (Suzuki GSXR1000). We wish them many long, safe and fun rides with the MSR.

The Club web site at www.melbsportsbike.net.au accumulated 609 hits during January, down 32 on last month. Total site visits are 80,307 since April 1996. The counters on the other pages after another month indicate that the 2012 Ride Calendar page took 584 hits (total 27,326 since 28th October 2008) and Great Roads 100 hits (total 6584). Status quo is maintained with the Home page taking slightly more hits than the Calendar page.

For <u>January</u> the official kilometres (sum of ride lengths) for the month is **4,010 km** (down 951 km on last month – Xmas Camp distorting December figures). Official Club kilometres for the month (people x ride length) is **42,320**, down 22,890 km on last month which was huge with Dargo weekend and the Porepunkah Xmas camp.

The average calendar **yearly total** is 346,862km since 2005. This year we are up to **43,320km** after 1 month with 1 minor crash.

The following **Special Resolution** is proposed by the Committee:
